

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the writer presents the conclusions of the study and gives some suggestions based on the result of the analysis and discussion on the previous chapter.

5.1. Conclusion

Based on result of the data analysis in chapter four, the writer concluded the following things:

1. The grammatical errors produced by the eleventh grade students of SMAN 3 Kupang in school year 2018/2019 were omission, addition, misformation and misordering. The total numbers of errors was 141.
2. The most common grammatical errors produced by the eleventh grade students of SMAN 3 Kupang in school year 2018/2019 were misformation (61,7%) made by 26 students, omission (34,1%) made by 24 students, misordering (3,5%) made by 5 students and addition (0,7%) made by 1 student.

5.2. Suggestion

Based on the conclusion, the writer would like to give the following suggestions for the English teacher at the school where the writer conducted the research.

1. The teacher should allocate more time to teach the students about basic English grammar and vocabulary besides improving their skill in listening, speaking, reading and writing.
2. If it is possible, the teacher gives the students more drills to deepen their basic English grammar every day. By doing this, the students will be accustomed with basic English grammar and vocabulary.

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
