

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the writer presents the conclusion of the study and gives suggestion.

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the result of the analysis, the writer comes to the conclusions. There are two conclusions answers for questions in the statement of the problems.

1. The eighth grade students of SMP Negeri 16 Kupang in the Academic year 2018/2019 were able to use Modal Auxiluries.
2. The student's ability level is fairly good (7.12%).

Based on the result of the analysis, the writer found some other additional conclusions. The students found difficulty in using appropriate modals such as shall, might, ought, and would. There are thirteen students (52%) passed the whole test while twelve students (48%) failed.

5.2 Suggestion

Going in line with the significance and data analysis of the study, some suggestion are proposed :

- a. For the Students
 1. The students are suggested to learn and keep improving their knowlegde and grammar in general and using Modal Auxiliaries in particular.

2. The students are expected not only to know the modals but also the rules and how to use them in certain contexts.

b. For the English Teachers

The teachers should teach the use of modal auxiliaries to the students. The emphasis should go to modals: shall, ought, might and would because many students committed errors on these modals.

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
