

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the writer would like to present two subchapters. They are conclusion and suggestion.

5.1 Conclusions

As has been stated above that the conclusion is based on the problem statement, objective, and data analysis. There are several morphosyntactic forms of expression of emotions in SolorLamaholot language that are presented below.

5.1.1 The Morphosyntactic Forms of Expression of SolorLamaholot Language

After analyzing the data containing morphosyntactic forms of expressions of emotions of SolorLamaholot Language, it can be concluded that mostly, those expression of emotions in SolorLamaholot Language are in form of clauses. The clauses are two types. The first clause is formed by a subject pronoun , an intransitive verb as the predicate of the clause. While the second clause is constructed with the possessed body part noun as a subject of the clause and intransitive verb as the predicate of the clause.

5.1.2 The Meaning of the Expressions of Emotions Used in Casual Speech of SolorLamaholot Language

By mapping their meanings, the emotions expressions of SolorLamaholot Language are divided into 9 categories. Each categories has generic and specific expressions. Category 1 refers to emotions of anger. Category 2 refers to feelings of love and desire. Category 3 refers to sadness of loss, being ignored, sympathy, and nostalgia. The expressions in Category 4 describe the feelings of joy and proud. Category 5 includes the expressions describing the feelings of fear or being scared and nervous. Category 6 includes the expression of shame. Category 7 includes the expressions describing the feelings of surprise. Category 8 includes the expressions describing the feelings of disappointment. Category 9 includes the expressions describing the feelings of disgust.

5.1.3 Suggestions

In line with the significance of the study and the result of data analysis a number of suggestion would be offered to many sides in accordance with their role, responsibility, capacity, and capability.

1. For expert of linguistics and other related subjects are suggested to do further study or similar study to confirm and extend the linguistics evidence in forms of morphosyntactic in SolorLamaholot language.
