

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the writer provides the conclusion of the study and he also offers some suggestions based on the data analysis.

5.1 Conclusion

After analyzing and then discussing about the errors committed by the students in writing descriptive text, it can be conclude that:

1. The errors made by students were omission, addition, misformation and misordering. The total number of grammatical erros made by students in constructing descriptive text is **81 (100%)**. Most of students made errors in misformation with the total number of error is 42 (52%), omission error is 20 (25%), addition error is 11 (13%) and misordering error is 8 (10%).
2. The most common error made by the students in writing descriptive text is misformation then followed by omission, addition and then misordering.

5.2 Suggestion

Besides concluding the study, the writer would like to give some suggestions to the teacher and the students that might be useful in improving the grammatical errors in writing especially in writing descriptive text.

1. For the Teacher

The teacher should teach the students how to create a good text in English, especially in writing descriptive text. And before that, the teacher should teach the students about the subject and verb agreement, how to make good sentences based on the tenses is used, and teacher should give the students chance to practice it.

2. For the Students

The students should learn how to write a good text and focused on grammar, especially tenses and the subject and verb agreement.

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
