1.2 Discussion

There are five categories of emotion words, they are anger, happiness, fear, surprise, and sadness. After analysis the data, it was showed that all of English emotion words tested have been acquired by 50% and more of the students. In terms of acquisition of words of each category, the most acquired words belong to the category of **surprise (92%)** and the least acquired words belong to the category of **fear (78%)**.
