

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the writer draws some conclusions and suggestions based on the data analysis of this study.

5.1 Conclusion

After analyzing and discussing the students error in writing descriptive text, the writer can conclude that:

1. The errors made by the eighth grade students of SMPK Sta. Maria Assumpta Kupang in the school year 2018/2019 in writing descriptive text were omission, addition, misformation and misordering. The number of errors in grammar was 154. The frequent errors in grammar was omission 89 (57.79%), addition 11 (7.14%), misformation 50 (32.47%) and misordering 6 (3.90%).
2. The most common grammatical error committed in writing descriptive text by the eighth grade students of SMPK Sta. Maria Assumpta Kupang is omission 89(57.79%).

5.2 Suggestion

The writer would like to give some suggestions to teachers and students that might be useful for improving the grammatical errors in writing descriptive text.

1. For the teacher

The teacher should give more emphasis on grammatical aspect especially in using simple present tense, auxiliary verb, pronoun, plural and singular, article, preposition, punctuation, capital letter also how to make good sentence because the students still lack of knowledge in these part.

2. For the students

The eighth grade students of SMPKSta. Maria Assumpta Kupang should learn more how to write a good text especially in using simple present tense, auxiliary verb, pronoun, plural and singular, article, preposition, punctuation, capital letter also how to make good sentence.

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
