

CHAPTER IV

FINDINGS AND DISCUSSIONS

In this chapter, the writer analyzed the data obtained by using descriptive analysis. The data were tabulated, described, and analyzed based on students' ability and level ability in using English Puns.

4.1. Findings

The obtained data was displayed to describe students' ability and level ability in using English Puns. Based on 20 items of question of students' ability in using English Puns, given to 30 tenth grade students of SMK Kencana Sakti Kupang, the writer found out some results as drawn in each table below;

In Table 4.1.1 the writer found out that there were 30 students answered 20 questions of using English puns. The mark (x) showed the wrong answer and the mark (v) showed the correct answer. The writer also found out that, the students used four kinds of English puns by answering the questions, they were; five item numbers of *Soundalike Puns*, seven item numbers of *Lookalike Puns*, three item numbers of *Close Sounding Puns* and five item numbers of *Texting Puns*.

In table 4.1.2, the writer presented the result of findings with the score to each student's answer in using English puns. Therefore, the correct answer was given score 5 (five) and the wrong answer was given score 0 (zero). The total highest score for 20-item number of questions must be 100 (5x20=100) or it accumulated by using the formula below;

Moreover, the score of each item number of using English puns could be seen by accumulating each score for 30 students. The total highest score for 30 students must be 100%.

4.2. Discussions

Based on the findings, the writer would like to discuss the results of students' ability and level ability in using English puns as follow:

1. Students' Ability in Using English Puns

The finding showed that 30 (100%) students answered 20 (100%) questions of using English puns. It meant that all of the students who were taken as sample answered the entire questions of using English puns. Table 4.1.2 showed that 10 (33.33%) students gave correct answer for question number one, 6 (20%) students were correct for question number two, 16 (53.33%) students answered correctly to question number three and 10 (33.33%) students gave correct answer for question number four. Moreover, there were 17 (56.66%) students were right for question number five, 6 (20%) students were correct for question number six and 23 (73.33%) gave correct answer to question number seven. Beside, 27 (90%) students answered

correctly to the question number eight while 7 (23.33%) students were correct for question number nine and 18 (60%) students gave correct answer to question number ten.

Furthermore, 10 (33.33%) students were right for question number eleven, 11 (36.66%) students were correct for question number twelve, 5 (16.66%) students gave correct answer to question number thirteen while, 4 (13.33%) students answered correctly to question number fourteen. Moreover, there were 13 (43.33%) students gave correct answer to question number fifteen, 20 (66.66%) students answered correctly to question number sixteen and 16 (53.33%) students were correct for question number seventeen. Finally, 23 (76.66%) students were right for question number eighteen, 20 (66.66%) students gave correct answer to question number nineteen and 5 (16.66%) students were correct for question number twenty. Therefore, the average of the students' ability in using English puns was 44.33% or got 44. Students' ability in using English puns was shown in the below table.

The result of this study showed each student's ability in using English puns. The student's ability started from the lowest score to the highest one. The score given to one question was 5, it described that one student got 25, three students got 30 then three students got 35, while seven students got 40, and six students got 45. Moreover, four students got 50, one student got 55, then four students got 60. Finally, one student got 65. Therefore, the lowest score got by the students was 25 and the highest one was 65. It could be said that the students' average percentage in using English puns was 44.33%. In defiled description, the writer drew each student total correct answer, percentage of correct answer and score in case of showing their ability in using English puns in table 4.2.2 below.

Moreover, the writer presented the students' ability in using English puns based on each kind of English puns, they were; *Soundalike Puns* that consisted of five questions where the average students got 39.33, *Lookalike Puns* which consisted of seven questions where the average students got 48.09. While *Close Sounding Puns* consisted of three questions and the average, students got 27.77. Finally, *Texting Puns* that consisted of 5 questions where the average students got 56. The average of the total students' ability in using English puns was 44.33. The detailed description was drawn in table 4.2.3 below.

2. Students' Level Ability In Using English Puns

Students' level ability was presented based on the range of the score level. It was discussed from the highest score level to the lowest score level ability. The results of the study showed that, there was 1 (3.33%) student got 65 or answered 65% correctly and 4 (13.33%) students got 60 or answered 60% correctly. While 1 (3.33%) student got 55 or answer 55% correctly, 4 (13.33%) students got 50 or answered 50% correctly then 6 (20%) students got 45 or answered 45% correctly and 7 (23.33%) students got 40 or answered 40% correctly. Therefore, 3 (10 %) students got 35 or answered 35% correctly, 3 (10%) students got 30 or answered 30% correctly, finally there was 1 (3.33%) students got 25 or answered 25% correctly. So the total of students' level ability was 44.33. The level of students' ability could be seen in the table 4.2.4 below.

Table 4.2.2, showed that students' level ability in using English puns were; 5 (16.66%) students got 65 and 60 or *average*, 5 (16.66%) students got 55 and 50 or *below average*, 13 (43.33%) students got 45 and 40 or *poor*, while 6 (20%) students got 35 and 30 or *very poor* and 1 (3.33%) students got 25 or *bad*. Finally, the total of students' level ability was 44.33 or *poor*.
