

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

Based on analysis presented in chapter IV, the writer would like to draw some conclusions and offer the suggestions as follows:

1.1 Conclusions

Going in line with the problem statements and data analysis then the writer concludes the study as the following:

1. The ability level of the eighth grade students of SMPK Sta. Familia is 93.9%. It is classified as very good.
2. The eighth grade students of SMPK Sta. Familia are able to pronounce the English irregular verbs.
3. Although the class ability is high, there are some difficulties faced by the students of SMPK Sta. Familia. They felt difficult in pronouncing: awoke, bite, cost, left, shake, shoot, wear, and wrung.

1.2 Suggestion
