

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the researcher wants to present conclusions and suggestions regarding this research. Conclusions are drawn based on the problem formulation and objectives as well as the results of data analysis. Suggestions are made based on the significance of the research, analysis results and conclusions.

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the findings from data analysis and discussion, the researcher reaches the following conclusions:

- a) Students in class VIIIA of SMP Negeri 6 Kupang Tengah in the 2023/2024 academic year were able to skim reading the text given to them. They were able to answer questions well.
- b) The average percentage of students' skimming ability is 74.2, this ability is classified as "**Fairly Good**".
- c) The difficulties faced by students in skimming were: the text had many new words or sentences that they were unfamiliar to, also some of them did not understand the instructions and questions. The allocated time was very insufficient for them.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the findings from the data analysis, discussion, and conclusions presented above, the researcher aims to offer several suggestions that could benefit English teachers and students of class 8A at SMP Negeri 6 Kupang Tengah.

The suggestions are:

A) For language teachers/reading course teachers

- a. Teachers should teach students how to skim texts correctly. Tell them how to read the text with the correct technique.
- b. The teacher should give students several texts to read as practice in continuous skimming.
- c. Teachers should not only provide reading texts but also train them to understand questions and answer them.

B) For students

- a) Students should try to skim the reading text continuously.
- b). Students must read various sources to achieve their knowledge and vocabulary, so that they do not have difficulty in understanding the questions.
