

## **CHAPTER V**

### **CONCLUSSION AND SUGESTION**

#### **5.1 Conclusion**

As stated in the first chapter, the purpose of this study is to describe students' ability in writing descriptive texts and to identify their ability at SMP Kristen Amanuban Barat. In this chapter, the researcher concludes the findings obtained from the data analysis. There are several conclusions presented here.

- 1 The study shows that eighth-grade students at SMP Kristen Amanuban Barat are still fairly good at writing descriptive texts. This is indicated by the test result, with a total score of 11.09.
- 2 However, the writing test also reveals that students face some difficulties in writing descriptive texts. Their problems include understanding the generic structure of descriptive texts, especially giving detailed descriptions, and mastering grammar, such as the simple present tense. In addition, most students find it difficult to construct sentences and spell words correctly.

## **5.1 Suguestions**

Based on the research findings, the writer would like to offer several suggestions derived from the conclusions above. Students are encouraged to review the lessons at home and improve their understanding of grammar, mechanics, and vocabulary related to descriptive texts by practicing writing. They should also give more attention to learning about descriptive texts.
