

## **CHAPTER V**

### **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

In this chapter the writer would like to draw some conclusions and suggestions based on the data analysis of this study.

#### **5.1 Conclusions**

After analyzing and discussing the student error in their writing descriptive text, the writer can conclude the following

- 1) The students committed errors in writing descriptive text. Types of errors made by the students were omission, addition, misformation, and misordering. It means that all students made errors in grammar. The number of errors in grammar was 80. The frequency of errors in grammar was omission 35 (43.75%), addition 13 (16.25%), misformation 27 (33.75%), and misordering 5 (6.25%).
- 2) The most frequent error was omission 35(43.75%). It means that the students have a big trouble with grammar especially in writing descriptive text.

#### **5.2 Suggestions**

The writer would like to give some suggestions to the teacher in general especially of SMPN 2 Bola, the writer, and the students of SMPN 2 Bola that might be useful for improving the grammatical errors in writing descriptive text.

##### **1. For the English Teachers in general especially of SMPN 2 Bola**

The teacher should teach the students how to write a good text especially in writing descriptive text and give the students chance to practice it. So the students should not only focus on the generic structure of descriptive text but also focus on grammar.

## **2. For the Writer**

The writer as a prospective teacher should know the kinds of text of English and their function and generic structure. As the prospective teacher, the writer should build her knowledge and develop both the writing skills and grammar aspect in English.

## **3. For the Students of SMPN 2 Bola**

The students have learnt more on how to write a good descriptive text by concerning the grammatical aspects regarding tenses, verb, noun and preposition. The students should not only focus on the generic structure of descriptive text but also focus on grammar.

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
