

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter, the writer presents the conclusions and suggestions related to the study. Based on the analysis, the writer comes to the following conclusions

#### 5.1 Conclusion

1. There are five expressions of Apology which have three types in Uab Meto such as apology to calm anger. For examples, *naika muto*'( don't be angry) and *naika mnek tenab* ( don't be bad thinking), the second type is apology from guilt for examples, au '*usanut au nekak* ( I humble myself) and *mumnauman kau* ( forgive me, have mercy on me). The third type is apology for being a polite person. For example, au '*toet maaf* ( I am sorry).
2. The most common used apology strategy in Uab Meto used by People in Oelneke village, TTU Regency are explanation and the acknowledgement of responsibility.

#### 5.2 Suggestions

Referring to the significance and the findings of the study, in the following suggestions are given.

##### 1. Experts of Linguistics

The experts of linguistics are suggested to do a further study to confirm and extend the linguistics evidence of expressions of Apology in Uab Meto.

## **2. Uab Meto Speaker**

Uab Meto Speakers especially elders should motivate the young people to keep their native language as their identity through organizing various kinds of competitions in national and religious events such as *Takanab* etc.

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
