

## CHAPTER V

#### 5.1 Conclusion

2. One of the difficulties faced or done by most students is how to construct question tag in the form of imperative sentence.

Examples number 6: Close the window,...? Number 11: Lets go to the flobamora mall together,...? Number 12: Let's have dinner in the restaurant this evening,...? More students completed the above exercises by using *do you, don't you, can you and shall you*.

The two students who got very bad level as well as the one who achieve bad level found almost all exercises as difficult.
