

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter contains conclusion and suggestions dealing with the result of data analysis as being discussed in chapter four.

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the data analysis presented in the previous chapter, the writer comes to conclusion. In this section, the writer presents important things related to the result of analyzing the data. There are some points found as below:

1. The eleventh grade students of SMAN 3 Kupang in the school year 2014/2015 commit grammatical errors in speaking, and they are Omission, Addition, Misformation and Misordering.
2. The most common grammatical errors in speaking committed by the eleventh grade students of SMAN 3 Kupang in the school year 2014/2015 is Misformation 69 (50.74%), followed by Omission 49 (36.02%), Addition 13 (9.56%) and the lowest presentation is Misordering 5 (3.68%).

5.2 Suggestions

Based on the conclusion, the writer would like to give the following suggestions:

1. The students should learn more on how to speak English by concerning the grammatical aspects regarding tenses, verb, noun, adjectives and preposition.
2. The English teachers should pay more attention on the students' grammatical errors by providing practices on grammatical aspects particularly tenses, verb, noun, conjunction, adjectives and preposition.

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
