

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the writer presents the conclusion of the study and gives suggestion.

5.1. Conclusion

Based on the result of the analysis, the writer comes to the conclusions. The first, the conclusions are the answers for questions in the statement of the problems.

1. The eight grade students of SMPK ST. THERESIA KUPANG were able to use English modals.
2. The student's ability level is fairly good (7.4%)
3. The students found difficulty in using the appropriate modals such as must, might, will, would, shall
4. There were eleventh students (60.87%) who passed the whole test while twelve students (39.13%) failed.

5.2 Suggestion

- a. For the students
 1. The students are suggested to learn and keep improving their knowlegde and grammar in general and use the English Modals in particular.

2. The students are expected not only to know the modals but also the rules and how to use them in certain contexts.
- b. For the teachers particularly the English teachers of the eleventh grade students of SMP Katolik ST. Theresia Kupang should teach the use of English modals to the students completely.

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
