

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter, the writer presents the conclusions and suggestions based on the result of the study.

5.1 Conclusions

Based on the result of data analysis, discussion and statement of the problems in the previous chapter, the conclusions are as follows:

1. The eighth grade students of SMPK ST. Theresia Kupang in the school year 2016/2017 are able to write recount text. All of the subjects (23 respondents) passed the writing recount based on the topic is given.
2. The ability level of eighth grade students of SMPK ST. Theresia Kupang in the school year 2016/2017 in writing recount text is good based on the analytic scoring system proposed by John Anderson.
3. The problems faced by the students are the use of grammatical aspects such as (simple past tense), the use of generic structure, how to put the commas and the full stops of the sentences and how to continue with capital after the full stop.

5.2 Suggestions

Based on the conclusions that the writer got from the data analysis, the writer would like to give some conclusions, which might be useful to the teaching of the English in general and particularly in the teaching of writing recount text.

Although the students are able to writing recount text, they committed many ungrammatical sentences. Therefore, the writer wants to suggest the following things to the teacher and the students.

1. The teacher should give more explanations to the students about the generic structure and the use of past verb.
2. The teacher should give more attention to students about the mechanics aspect especially in writing a recount text
3. The students should be focus on the teacher's explanation so they cannot do the same mistakes again.

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
