

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter is about conclusion and suggestion dealing with the result of data analysis as has been discussed in chapter four.

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the data analysis presented in the previous chapter, the writer comes to the conclusion. The writer presents important things related to the result of analyzing of the data. There are some points found as follows:

1. The grammatical errors that made by the students in constructing descriptive text is 117 (100%). The writer found all the types of errors, namely Omission 64 (55%), Addition 13 (11%), Misformation 33 (28%) and Misordering 7 (6%).
2. The most common grammatical errors committed by the students in writing descriptive text is **Omission 64 times** (55%). In the second position is Misformation, and it followed by Addition and Misordering.

5.2 Suggestion

Referring to the data analysis and conclusion above, the writer suggests some ideas to be considered:

1. The students should master grammatical aspects in producing a text in order descriptive text when they want to be able to communicate in writing.
2. Realizing that poor grammar in writing can violate the content of the writing, the writer suggests that it should be better for English teacher to teach and really pay attention to the grammatical aspects of writing.

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
